## **SALEM SCHOOL BOARD MINUTES SALEM SCHOOL DISTRICT January 10, 2022**

The Board of Education of the Salem School District #30, State of Arkansas, met in regular session Monday, January 10, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in the Boardroom on the high school campus. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Coffman.

### ROLL CALL:

The Chairman declared a quorum present and opened the meeting for business.

The minutes from the December 20, 2022 regular meeting were reviewed. Miller made the motion with a second by Hall to approve the minutes as written.

Superintendent Guiltner gave a COVID update to the board. After discussing numbers and cases the board decided to make no new recommendations. We will continue to recommend mask but not required.

Mr. Guiltner reported on Act 1029 of 2019, "bullying report". The high school reported 20 – isolated incidents, 2 - 2<sup>nd</sup> time incidents and 0 – 3<sup>rd</sup> time incidents. The elementary school reported 5 – isolated incidents, 2 – 2<sup>nd</sup> time incidents and 0 – 3<sup>rd</sup> time incidents.

The financial reports were reviewed and accepted on a motion made by Hall with a second by Smith.
