

**SALEM SCHOOL BOARD MINUTES**  
**SALEM SCHOOL DISTRICT**  
**December 16, 2013**

The Board of Education of the Salem School District #30, state of Arkansas, met in regular session on Monday, December 16, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. in the boardroom on the high school campus. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Coffman.

The Chairman declared a quorum present and opened the meeting for business.
